***Textbook and School Supplies:** VF requires that a \$900 Line of Credit be set up with the Cadet Store for the purchase of textbooks and school supplies and for the replacement of lost uniform items and equipment. For further details, please contact the Cadet Store.

****Security Deposit:** The Security Deposit is a refundable charge required of all Cadets as a contingency against lost or damaged equipment or property owned by Valley Forge Military Academy and College. The Security Deposit may **not** be applied to personal charges for clothing or equipment.

Uniform Replacement: Classroom and dress uniforms outgrown or in need of replacement due to “fair wear and tear” will be replaced on a direct exchange basis without charge. All other replacements must be purchased. Limited Cavalry items are available for purchase.

Spending Money: An “allowance account” can be set up with the Cadet Store for a fixed amount of cash to be given to the cadet on a weekly basis. The Follett Company, a separate entity, charges a \$25 fee to administer allowances. For further details, please contact the Cadet Store at (610) 687-6061.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAM CHARGES

*****Health Center Charges:** The fee covers all injury and sick visits. It does not include expenses incurred for medication, supplies and durable equipment.

Health Insurance: There is a Health Insurance Plan available for Students.

******MEDICAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM:** There is an assessment made for the management of medications administered to students on a daily basis.
