He must possess outstanding leadership ability and high moral character and demonstrate outstanding tactical ability. Preference to a cadet whose goal is military career.

Cadet Michael N. McCoy Drug Awareness Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy cadets. In addition to the VFMAC Common Scholarship Application, cadets submit a written essay on topic of drug awareness (800 to 1000 words); STEP cadets are encouraged to apply.
Richard R. McCullough '45 Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy cadets with outstanding academic records and demonstrated financial need; preference for cadets who qualify for Regimental Band.

MAJ Norman Mitterling Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy cadets, with preference to a minority or urban cadet.
R. Alexander Montgomery Scholarship	This is an unrestricted scholarship available to any new and returning Academy cadets.
Anna Dean Murphy Fund	Available to new and returning Academy cadets of high scholastic standing who, but for the financial assistance provided by the scholarship, would not be able to attend Valley Forge Military Academy.

American Legion Post 418 Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning College cadets nominated by the Commandant and chosen on the merits of leadership qualities. Preference to the child of a veteran and to the cadet commanders.
Frank A. Ashbridge '59C Scholarship Fund	Available to new and returning college cadets with demonstrated financial need.
Jess A. Bell Endowed Scholarship	Available to new College cadets who are athletes with good academic records and demonstrated financial need.
Father James Fontain Scholarship	Available to returning College cadets who have worked in the Chapel. In keeping with Father Fontain's wishes, preference is given to a returning cadet with financial need and has selflessly assisted the Chaplain in his duties.
Fralely-Martin/D Troop Endowed Scholarship	Available to College D Troop returning cadets with demonstrated financial need.
Vera Greiner Memorial Music Band Endowed Scholarship	Available to a College cadet who plays the flute in the band.
Mustang Scholars Endowed Fund	Available to College cadets participating in ROTC.
Grace S. and Rear Admiral W. Linton Nelson Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning College cadets with financial need.

Preference is given to male applicants.

Nancy Wenzel Athletic Achievement Award	Available for a returning College cadet, serving in a leadership role, and who maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA.
Thomas D. White II Endowed Scholarship	Available for new and returning College cadets with financial need. Preference as follows: 1) a son of an alumnus, 2) a relative of an alumnus, and 3) the son of an active duty member of the United States armed force.

Alumni Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy and College cadets who are children of Forge Alumni with demonstrated financial need.
LTG Milton G. Baker Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy and College cadets who possess a high moral character, are diligent and studious and exemplify for the honor and traditions for VFMAC. Preference to cadets with a strong commitment to Christian beliefs.
Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy and College cadets. The purpose of the scholarship is to financially assist the grandson of a member of "Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge" who has qualified for admission or re-enrollment at VFMAC. Preference to grandsons of member of the Delaware Valley Chapter. If no cadet meets these qualifications, then the scholarship can be awarded to any cadet of good academic and tactical standing with financial need.

Reader's Digest Endowed Scholarship Fund	Available to returning Academy and College cadets who completed at least one full year at Valley Forge and have demonstrated financial need. Award renewed contingent on good academic standing and financial need.
George W. Rentschler and Samuel Evans III '42 Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy and College cadets who will contribute to and are an asset to Valley Forge Military Academy and College; non-need based.
Rockwell Foundation Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning College and Academy with financial need. First preference to College Bandsmen, then Academy Bandsmen.
Jon B. Singer '60, '62C Endowed Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy and College cadets with financial need.
Harrison C. Stackpole '32 Scholarship	Available to new and returning Academy and College cadets with financial need from Western Pennsylvania, preferred DuBois or St. Mary's Pennsylvania.
MAJ A. Robert Toal Memorial Scholarship	Preference to returning Academy and College Bandsmen who demonstrate the finest characteristics of leadership, academic achievement, and morals.
COL William C. Golden and Mr. Howard Barringer Endowed Scholarship	Preference to Academy, available to Academy and College cadets in grades 11 or 12 or College cadets with good academic records and demonstrated financial need.
